

## **TELEVISION HIRE**

### **ELIGIBILITY**

This facility is available to all members, members spouse and any dependent child of the member (providing the child is not in a children's ward) who is in hospital for a period of at least 24 hours.

### **CONTINUITY**

This facility is provided for as long as the eligible person remains an inpatient of any public or private hospital for any reason other than for the treatment of drug/alcohol dependency and/or psychological treatment.

### **AMOUNT**

The Society will pay for the supply and installation of the television set and the daily rental fee.

### **CLAIMING**

The Welfare Society Station Representative will attempt to ascertain on his initial visit to the member in hospital, the expected duration of hospitalisation. In the case of the spouse or dependent child it is the responsibility of the member to advise the WSSR and or the Society office of his wish to have a television set provided by the Society.

The WSSR and or shall make arrangements for the hireage of a television set through the normal hospital booking agency.

NB. This benefit is only provided where:

- The rental of television sets to patients is an accepted policy of the hospital administration.
- The person in charge of the patient has given approval.
- The hireage of television sets is a normal facility in the particular institution.
